**Regular School Board Meeting**  
**October 12, 2022**

Members present Brenda Buri, Josh Sundsbak, Chad Brown, Jayme Burkhart, and Amy Ralph. Also present were Superintendent Christopher Bachmeier, Business Manager Jody Askvig, Elementary Principal Kayla Andersen, Dean of Students/AD Scott Medalen, and JH/Asst. Elementary Principal Josh Brown.

Board president Buri called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

A motion was made by Burkhart and seconded by Brown to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Sundsbak and seconded by Brown to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as presented. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Sundsbak and seconded by Burkhart to approve the Activity report as of 9-30-2022 as presented. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Brown and seconded by Burkhart to accept the financial reports for the General fund, the Building fund and the Hot Lunch fund as presented. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Burkhart and seconded by Sundsbak to approve open enrollment forms numbered 21,22 and 23 for the 22-23 school year. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ralph and seconded by Brown to approve the second and final reading of Policy FFD- Possessing Weapons as presented. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Brown and seconded by Sundsbak to approve the Superintendent Evaluation as discussed. Motion carried.

Principal report: Mrs. Andersen- students enjoyed the school-wide pep rally in Des Lacs. PK went to the Pumpkin Patch. Elementary school sold donuts and raised \$1300 for Brave the Shave. Star Laker was for Empathy. Elementary is holding a Little Caesar Pizza online fundraiser. At the PD Day the elementary school worked on the new Reading Curriculum and relationship mapping. Upcoming items- P/T conferences are October 17 & 18<sup>th</sup> and STEAM night is October 25<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Brown- Working with some Gifted and Talented students at the elementary to help challenge them. New 2<sup>nd</sup> 9 week quarter

rotation begins on October 17<sup>th</sup> for JH students. Working on interventions for the students that are in need. Mr. Medalen- Updates on homecoming week, ASVAB test, PSAT test, College Application Day for seniors, Seniors did job shadows, Jostens visited with Juniors and Seniors, 20 students attended FBLA convention in Bismarck and FCCLA had an event at the Pumpkin Patch. On the sports side- We hosted the Girls State Class B Golf Tournament in Minot and the Laker Invite VB tournament at Des Lacs and Burlington. Region and state Cross Country are coming up. JH VB finished, and JH FB will be done on October 13<sup>th</sup>. Varsity FB will host first play off game on October 20<sup>th</sup>. Linda Miller resigned as head girls' golf coach.
